Project Overview

Scope of Works

- Installation of **new skylights** to improve natural light and ventilation.
- Replacement of slate roofing to restore weatherproofing and structural integrity.
- Implementation of a **man-safe system** to support future maintenance access and safety compliance.
- Construction of a **fully sealed internal birdcage scaffold**, creating a temporary roof to protect sensitive lab environments during external works.

Challenges & Solutions

Working directly above active research labs presented significant logistical and safety challenges. Quest Interiors coordinated closely with lab users and facilities teams to phase the works and ensure zero disruption to ongoing experiments. The bespoke internal scaffold solution provided full containment, allowing roof works to proceed safely and efficiently.
